Theoretical Postmodernity

- Masters of Suspicion
 - o Marx: It's all about money.
 - o Nietzche: It's all about power.
 - o Freud: It's all about sex.
- Metanarratives and Local Narratives
 - o The big stories are dead
 - o "What's it mean to me?"

Practical Postmodernity

- Not "Is it true?" but "Is it real?"
 - o You're thinking, "That's the same thing!" Not quite.
 - Example: You tell a kid not to do drugs. "Why?" he says. "Because it's against the law." But then the kid says, "You speed all the time, and that's against the law too."
 - The command is *true*, but the kid wants to see that it is *real in your life*—he wants to see you *do it*, if you want him to do it.
- Is this shift a bad thing?
 - o Shouldn't be. God made us to respond to that kind of persuasion.
 - o John 17:20-23

What's the good news here?

- Postmoderns are people too. They have the same needs as other people:
 - Hope
 - o Forgiveness and absolution from sin
 - o Love
 - o For life to make sense
- "But they shoot all that stuff down!"
- Yes, they do. But God cheats. Keep telling God's story. Keep offering hope, forgiveness, and love, and God will help them to need it more.
